Expected outcomes

- Discuss the next steps -in terms of improvements, new models runs- of WP5. Determine main policy implications and propose a strategy for dissemination of results before and after Copenhagen. Different models could be used for different purposes, even outside the scenario exercise. Need to come up with policy recommendations for the EU.
- Discuss strength and weaknesses of technology assessments and their potential use both as stand-alone and in conjunction with models.
- Define the strategy for the stochastic runs. To what extent will models be able to "harmonize" or pursue similar exercises? Being able to deliver clear cut policy messages seems especially hard when dealing with uncertainty.
- · Generally speaking: how can we best use all the material we're putting together?

Logistics

Dinner on Thursday 18th

The boat tour and dinner will leave from San Giorgio Island at 630pm. For those partners that are not attending the IEW, these are the instructions on how to get to San Giorgio:

The water bus to use is line 2. Line 2 leaves from Ferrovia (railway station), Piazzale Roma (Car and Bus terminal), Zattere and San Zaccaria with a frequency of 10 minutes.

From the St. Mark's area, the line 2 water bus stop, San Zaccaria, can be found on the Riva degli Schiavoni - the promenade located to the left of St. Mark's Square (facing the waterfront). From St. Mark's Square turn left and proceed along the promenade crossing over two bridges. After the second bridge you will see two landing stages (one before the statue of Vittorio Emanuele, and one after). Line 2 water bus leaves for the San Giorgio Island (only one stop) with a journey time of approximately 3 minutes from the first landing stage. One stop ticket costs € 2,00. Boats leave every ten minutes "on the nine", so the 609 and 619 are the last ones that will get you there before the 630 departure time.
